

## 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Hometown Celebration PARKING INFORMATION

### July 4 -7

- Free parking is available on both sides of Main Street (Route 1).
- There is a free covered parking garage located on the east side of Maine Street across from the L.L.Bean Campus.
- **Handicapped parking** on the L.L.Bean campus is located in the Bear Lot behind the Discovery Stage.

### July 7 only

On Saturday, July 7 a portion of Main Street will be closed to traffic throughout the day.

- Alternate routes for northbound and southbound through traffic will be well marked.
- Satellite parking serviced by free shuttles will be available from 7:00 a.m. until Midnight, or as long as needed to get everyone back to their vehicles. These locations will be well marked.
  - Locations are:
    - <u>Double L Street and Casco Street</u> off Route 1 In-town shuttle stop is located at the Town Hall
    - <u>Campus Drive</u> off of Desert Road: All **RV parking** and overflow In-town shuttle stop is located at the corner of Main Street and Justin's Way
- Customers who are staying at any hotel on Route 1 south of downtown Freeport from
  the Hampton Inn to the Best Western will have access to a free shuttle that will be
  running a loop approximately every hour between 10 a.m. and Midnight. In-town shuttle
  stop is located is located at the Town Hall
- There is an ADA wheelchair accessible bus available all day.
- **Bike Valet:** There will be extra bike racks available in the Coyote Lot behind the Hunting & Fishing store. The Bicycle Coalition of Maine will staff volunteers to secure bikes during the day. This service is available between **10:00 a.m. and 6:30 p.m.**
