

How to Care For Your L.L.Bean Holiday Evergreens

Holiday evergreens are handcrafted exclusively for L.L.Bean and then shipped directly to you to ensure maximum freshness.



UPON DELIVERY

We packed your fresh evergreens tightly for shipping. After unpacking, please allow the branches a few hours to relax into their normal, full shape. Feel free to trim and/or fluff greenery ends and bows, as preferred.

Some loose needles in the carton is a natural, unavoidable occurrence called “sprilling” – it is not a cause of concern.

BEFORE DISPLAYING

Please be sure to protect the surface your greenery rests upon from moisture damage and scratches. If you are not displaying right away, please store in a cool place.

WREATHS

- Hang your wreath outside your storm door or in a sheltered location.
- If hanging indoors, mist it every other day to keep the boughs fresh.

CENTERPIECES

- Thoroughly water your new centerpiece. Please water it every few days.
- Place candle(s) securely in holders (if applicable)
- For your safety, with centerpieces using taper candles, use only the self-extinguishing candles provided. Please remember, never leave burning candles unattended.

TABLETOP TREES

- Place tree in sink or bucket and slowly pour two quarts of water down from the top.
- Repeat at least once a day for the first three days. You may need to loosen the wrap around the tree base before watering. Then, water the tree as often as a houseplant.
- Live Alberta spruce can be planted outside after the holidays. Please refer to additional instructions.

LIGHTED PRODUCTS
