

Rangeley Maine Bird Hunting Adventure

Trip Details

Locations: Freeport and Rangeley, Maine

Duration: 5 Days/4 Nights

Accommodations: 5-star inn (one night) & rustic sporting camps (three nights)

Activity Level: Easy

Group Size: Four bird hunters (not including possible additional non-hunting guests)

Minimum age: 12 (17 and under with parent or guardian)

Climate Information: October is when we see more consistently cool weather. A warm day can be mixed in here or there, but it's best to plan on bringing some of your cool-weather clothing. Average daily temperature: high 50°F/low 30°F.



Daily Itinerary

Day 1 Personalized Clay Shooting Lessons

An L.L.Bean trip guide will meet guests at the Portland International Jetport baggage claim area at 9:00 a.m. Once gathered, we'll shuttle together to the charming town of Freeport, L.L.Bean's hometown for over a century.

If driving to Maine or flying into Portland the night before, please plan to meet us at our Fogg Farm instructional facility at 9:30 a.m. where we will kick off our trip. Fogg Farm is located at 11 Desert Road, Freeport, Maine (the first white house with red roof on the left side of Desert Road as you head west).

At L.L.Bean's private shooting range, you will spend a few hours clay shooting with a world-class expert at your side. Our instructors are excited to share their wingshooting tips and techniques and help create a perfect, personal adventure, suited to your bird hunting needs.

After lunch, we'll travel down the street for an exclusive tour of our Freeport retail campus, including our popular Hunting & Fishing Store. Here, you'll find everything you need for

this adventure – and many more. Guests can also sign up with a personal shopper to help guide them through our many options and find the best gear for this trip. Our Hunting & Fishing Store is open 24 hours – all you need to do is sign up!

Following our visit to the Flagship campus, we'll head down the street to Harraseeket Inn, our accommodation for the night. After checking in, you'll have time to either relax or see what else Freeport has to offer. Your L.L.Bean Trip Leader will be there to help guide you in the right direction.

We'll end the day with dinner at Broad Arrow Tavern, one of Harraseeket Inn's signature restaurants. Eat at your own schedule or join your fellow travelers.

Fishing: Bring along your fly rod! Our lake is known for spectacular brook trout and salmon fishing. (Fishing licenses available for purchase at camp lodge.)

Canoeing: Experience the famous "Moose Run," an exciting canoe wildlife adventure trip on the upper Kennebago River.

Hiking: Lace up your boots, grab a map and hit the trails. There are many great hiking options in the area.

Lake touring: Enjoy a self-guided lake tour of historic Kennebago Lake. Learn more about the special events and landmarks that make this area unique.

At the end of the day, we'll meet back at camp to enjoy a hearty, home-cooked meal together.

Firearms & Ammunition

While at our Fogg Farm instructional facility, we will have all necessary shooting equipment available for your use (shotguns, ammunition, clays, ear and eye protection). If you have traveled with your own firearm and would like to use it while at Fogg Farm, you are welcome to - providing it passes inspection by L.L.Bean staff before use.

While hunting at the sporting camps, you will be responsible for providing your own gun and ammunition. Our Adventure Consultants are available to answer questions regarding best practices for transporting your firearm. A wide range of ammunition is available for purchase while at our Hunting & Fishing Store in Freeport.
